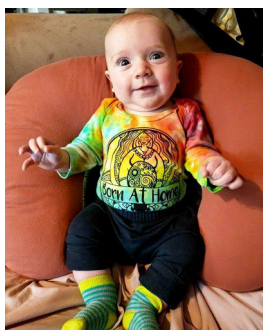

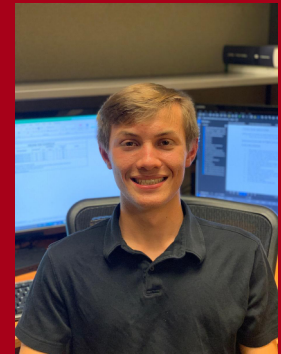
Intech Holiday Party

New Natural Resources Headquarters (NNRH)

Intech Mechanical is proud to be part of the team who recently completed the New Natural Resource Headquarters (NNRH) Building located downtown Sacramento at 7th & P Street. The 21 Story State office building is 875,000 sqft and will be the new home of 3,450 state employees. The new building is Zero Net Energy, LEED Platinum and uses 50% less water than typical office buildings.

Intech Mechanical was the designated Design Builder for the new Plumbing system with a final contract value of \$11.5M. The Plumbing field team which peaked out at 22 plumbers was successfully led by General Forman Chris Werderman and Project Superintendent Kevin Richardson. The project kicked off in early design phases in January of 2018, lead by Gary Risse and Jenna Baker. The project recently completed with a contractual completion date of August 27th, 2021.

This long project had many hurdles to jump through, but we can proudly say the Intech family crushed it utilizing all our resources from successful conceptual estimating, an awesome BIM team, thoughtful pre-fabrication and quick field install. A shout out to every individual who worked on this project is well deserved! Lets do it again!
